**LINC** is a park-based summer internship program for current high school students who are open to new experiences, are eager to learn new skills and enjoy working outside.

During the six week long program, students assist with service projects, gain career and leadership skills, and take field trips to special park sites such as Alcatraz and Muir Woods.

Projects and activities vary by week and include trail work, growing plants, and habitat restoration. NO EXPERIENCE necessary.

The Program will begin with a 4-day camping trip at a National Park, during which participants will support a service project, engage in team building, explore the sites, and go on an adventurous hike. This year the program will culminate with a special 4-day backpacking expedition across the Golden Gate National Parks.
