Criteria

- Location: Photos must have been taken within the region defined as Mt. Tamalpais (see map here). Photos may have been taken at any time in, as long as they have been taken by you.
- Size: Photos will be scaled to fit about 8.5x11 inch size, so please make sure your digital files or scans are high resolution (at least 300 dpi).
- Deadline: Photos will be accepted starting August 15, 2016 until October 14, 2016. Photos submitted after this date will not be entered in the contest.
- Number of entries: Limit 3 entries per person.

Submission instructions

- Entries must be submitted by email to mgentile@parksconservancy.org. You may use a file transfer service (e.g., Box, Dropbox).
- You must complete an entry form and submit it with your photos. File names must match the file names on the entry form. Photos that are misnamed or photos submitted without an entry form will not be accepted. If you do not wish to title your photos, name them "untitled1", "untitled2", etc.
- File names should use the following format: title_initials_mm-dd-yyyy
 - Example: tam_at_dusk_abc_7-19-2016
- Scans of printed photos are accepted.
- Only minimal photo correction allowed.

Eligibility

You must be registered to attend the Mt. Tam Science Summit to enter. Photos must be the work of the entrant. If you cannot attend but would still like to enter, contact mgentile@parksconservancy.org.

Prizes and Judging

- Gift cards from local Marin businesses will be awarded to three winners, as well as a copy of the updated *Mt. Tamalpais Trails* book by Barry Spitz.
- All photos entered will be printed and displayed at the 2016 Mt. Tam Science Summit.
- All photos entered will be displayed in an online gallery on the One Tam website.
- Photos will be assessed by at least two volunteer judges on their creativity and photographic quality.
