In 2014, the four public agencies responsible for Mt. Tam (California State Parks, Marin County Parks, Marin Municipal Water District, and the National Park Service) teamed with the nonprofit Golden Gate National Parks Conservancy to form the Tamalpais Lands Collaborative (TLC). The TLC collectively leverages resources and expertise for the care of the mountain in a more seamless and strategic manner. It undertakes its work through One Tam – a community initiative focused on engaging the public and building long-term support.
